Saskatchewan quick facts

- Affordable living costs.
- 100,000 more jobs by 2030. Learn more in *Saskatchewan's Growth Plan*.
- Regina is the provincial capital (population 228,900).
- Saskatoon is the largest city (population 273,000).
- Saskatchewan has a four-season climate: fall, winter, spring and summer.
- Half the province is covered by forest; one-third is farmland; one-eighth is fresh water.
- Saskatchewan has the most attractive permanent residency laws in Canada for students looking to immigrate to Canada. Check the **Saskatchewan Immigrant Nominee Program** for more information.

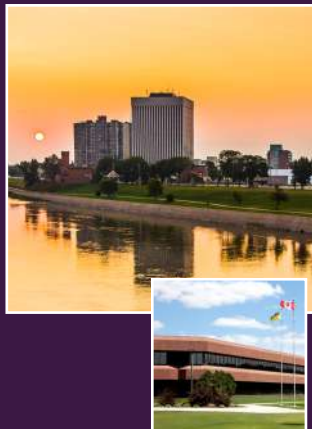
Saskatchewan's Growth Plan for 2020–2030: a growing province and a strong economy with 100,000 more jobs. (source: saskatchewan.ca)

Graduate Retention Program

The Graduate Retention Program (GRP) provides a tax credit for graduates who live and file an income tax return in Saskatchewan after graduation. Students can receive up to \$20,000 of their tuition back in the form of a tax credit after studying with us.

The Saskatchewan government is actively trying to attract young people to the province and has progressively introduced new pathways. We have the lowest percentage of 18- to 64-year-old people in the country—this is the labour force.

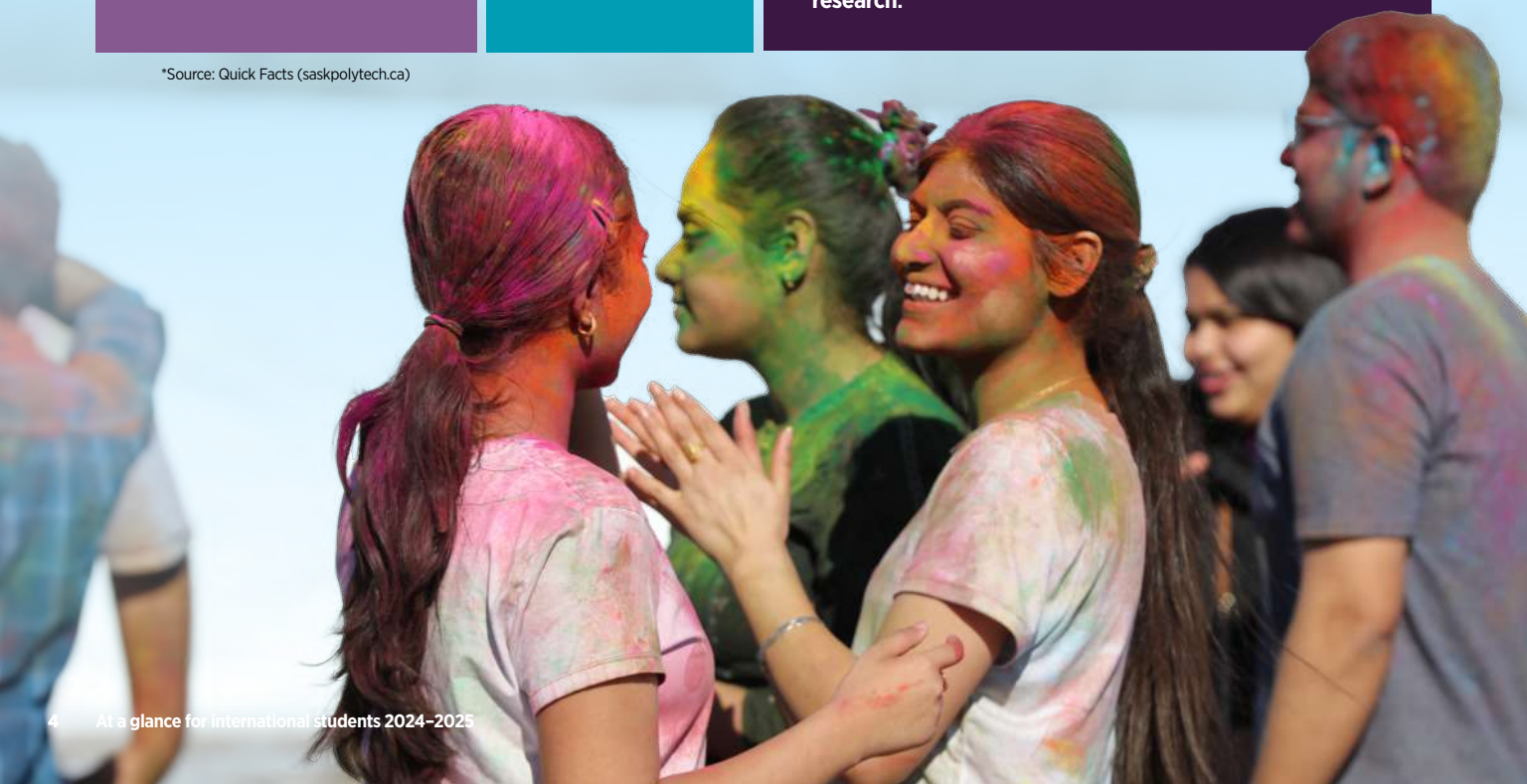
