## APPLICATION PERIOD

The program is open for application from 8:00 a.m., October 1, 2016, to 4:30 p.m., February 15, 2017 (Saskatchewan time).

All supporting documents (i.e., transcripts) must be submitted to Saskatchewan Polytechnic by March 1, 2017.

NOTE: For international applicants with student visas, the application period closes at 4:30 p.m., December 31, 2016, and all supporting documents must be submitted by January 31, 2017.

## \*SWIFT CURRENT APPLICANTS

First priority is given to applicants who are residents of the Cypress Health Region. See [www.cypresshealth.ca](http://www.cypresshealth.ca) for the areas belonging to this region.

## HIGH SCHOOL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants who have completed or are in the process of completing Grade 12 must present the following courses for admission to the program. GED is not accepted in lieu of Grade 12:

- English Language Arts A30 (or French substitution)
- English Language Arts B30 (or French substitution)
- One of Foundations of Math 30 or Pre-calculus 30
- Biology 30
- Chemistry 30

Students must have a minimum grade of **70% in each** of the above required courses. Students applying from other Canadian provinces and territories or from other countries will need to present equivalent courses. Meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee admission to the program.

Students who are currently enrolled in high school and have not yet graduated will be considered under the University of Regina Early Conditional Admission process. High school graduates will be assessed using the five courses listed above.

## POST-SECONDARY ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants who have completed a minimum of 15 credit hours of approved post-secondary education by the application deadline (Feb 15) will be admitted based on the following criteria. Meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee admission to the program.

- Successful completion of either each high school course (listed above) or a post-secondary equivalent or higher than equivalent, **and**
- A minimum of 65% UGPA on all post-secondary courses completed

## ADDITIONAL PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

By August 1 prior to the beginning of the first term, students admitted to the SCBScN program must:

- Obtain a criminal record check and vulnerable sector search (dated within six [6] months of the start date of the program)
- Complete Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System (WHMIS) course
- Provide a record of immunization
- Complete a Standard First Aid course
- Complete CPR Health Care Provider course

Students must complete a Transferring, Lifting, and Repositioning (TLR®) course by November 1.

## ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS

## OUT-OF-PROVINCE APPLICANTS

Out-of-province applicants will need to meet the same requirements as Saskatchewan applicants. Out-of-province course equivalents will be used to meet the admission requirements for this program.

## TRANSCRIPTS

All official transcripts must be submitted to Saskatchewan Polytechnic directly from the office maintaining official records. Applicants who have attended high school in **Saskatchewan** must arrange for **electronic** copies of their transcripts to be sent to Saskatchewan Polytechnic directly from the Saskatchewan Ministry of Education. Requests to the Saskatchewan Ministry must be made online at [www.education.gov.sk.ca/transcripts](http://www.education.gov.sk.ca/transcripts).

If you wish to have fall semester course grades calculated towards admission, submit an official interim (semester 1) transcript for the applicable secondary or post-secondary institution you are attending, by **March 1, 2017**. All official **final** transcripts must be received by Saskatchewan Polytechnic by **August 1, 2017**.

Transcripts are not accepted directly from applicants. Do not have your transcripts sent to the University of Regina.
