PURPOSE

Student evaluation at Saskatchewan Polytechnic (Sask Polytech) must be a fair and transparent process ensuring all graded assessments are aligned to learning outcomes and are developed and conducted in the best interests of student learning while maintaining appropriate standards. This policy, and its associated procedures, provides information related to various aspects of the evaluation of student learning at Sask Polytech.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all Sask Polytech credentialed programs and all Sask Polytech credit courses. For collaborative programs, the evaluation procedures of the credential granting institution are followed.

POLICY

At the beginning of each Sask Polytech credit course, students will be provided with a course outline that provides the course description, pertinent course information, learning outcomes and assessment tools. Sask Polytech credit courses may use a variety of assessments that link directly to the learning outcomes in order to evaluate student learning.
