



# 2019 - 20 Student Engagement Survey Results

## Institutional Research and Analysis

### Introduction

The Institutional Research and Analysis (IR&A) unit at the Saskatchewan Polytechnic ("Sask Polytech") annually surveys its current students in certificate, diploma, and degree programs to understand their experience and levels of engagement at Sask Polytech. In particular, students are asked about their learning experience, their perceptions of admission and orientation, their satisfaction with campus facilities and the quality of interactions with other students, faculty and student services. This report presents the findings from the 2019-20 survey.

In the 2019-20 academic year, 6,697 students were invited to participate in the survey between November 2019 and June 2020. In total, 3,150 completed the questionnaire. The response rate was 47 percent.

### Data Limitation

At the institution level, the results from this survey are very reliable with a margin of error of +/- 1.3 percent at a 95 percent confidence level. However, results at program levels may not be statistically reliable due to small sample sizes. Caution is needed when interpreting those results.

### How to Use This Workbook

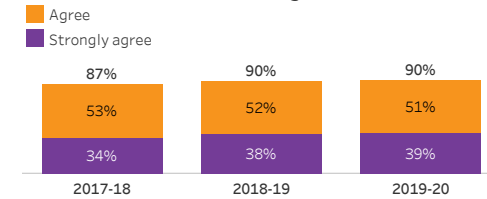
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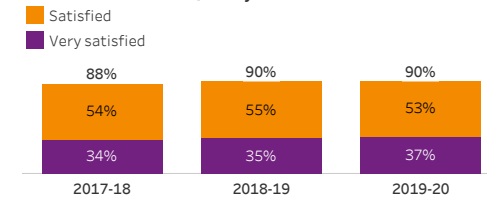
### Institutional Highlights

- \* Nine in ten (90%) respondents surveyed were either satisfied or very satisfied with their program, consistent with the 2018-19 results.
- \* A strong majority (90%) of respondents continued to be satisfied with the quality of instruction they received at Sask Polytech.
- \* Satisfaction with the facilities at Sask Polytech remained moderately strong (86% either satisfied or very satisfied).
- \* Similar as the 2018-19 result, nearly nine in ten (88%) respondents either agreed or strongly agreed that the program orientation was effective in orienting them through their program and explaining the requirements of their program.
- \* Nine in ten (91%) respondents agreed or strongly agreed that they felt safe and secure on campus, three percentage points down from last year (94%).
- \* One in five (20%) respondents had left their program for at least one term or an extended period during their study or were seriously considering leaving. Perceived low quality of their program, academic difficulties and financial issues were among main reasons for leaving.

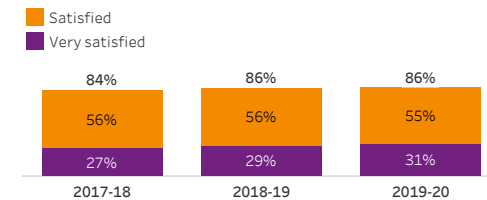
Overall Satisfaction with Program
