# Institutional Research and Analysis

#### Introduction

Saskatchewan Polytechnic ("Sask Polytech") annually surveys its graduates in certificate, diploma, and degree programs to determine their employment status six months to a year after graduation.

Graduates are asked to report on their employment status, employment in a training related occupation, location of employment, overall satisfaction with their program, as well as satisfaction with preparedness for employment in a training related field.

This edition of the graduate follow-up survey will be of particular interest considering the impacts of the Covid-19 pandemic. The institutional highlights page will endeavour to bring out a comparison of Sask Poly student success pre- and post- pandemic.

The survey of 2019-20 graduates was launched and completed in April to June of 2021. Out of a valid sample of 3,846 graduates, 2,251 completed the survey, for a 59% response rate (very close to the 60% response rate obtained in the 2018-19 graduate survey).

#### **Data Limitation**

At institution level, the results from this survey are very reliable with a margin of error of +/- 1.3% at a 95% confidence level. Results at the program level may not be statistically reliable due to small sample sizes. Caution is needed when interpreting those results.

#### How to Use This Workbook

To use this workbook, select the name of the program, credential, school, administering campus and program type from the filters on the first survey summary page. Once selections have been made, browse the dashboard to view the survey results.

Graduates from programs delivered by Sask Polytech and from brokered programs were surveyed. To see the results for programs delivered by Sask Polytech only, please unchecked the "Con Ed - Brokered" option in the Base/Con Ed/Brokered filter.

# Institutional Research and Analysis

#### **Highlights**

The highlights of 2019-20 Graduate Follow-up Survey Results focus on programs delivered by Sask Polytech only (excluding brokered programs) unless otherwise stated.

Due to rounding, some combined totals could be 1% plus or minus the actual disaggregated values.

#### Respondent profile

- \*Of the 1,952 students from Sask Polytech delivered programs, one quarter (25%) graduated from the School of Business.
- \*Seven in ten (73%) graduates were from base programs.
- \*12% of respondents identified themselves as of indigenous origin.

#### **Employment Outcomes**

- \* Overall employment rate was 94%, largely consistent from the results of previous two years.
- \* As effects of the covid pandemic continue to impact Saskatchewan's economy, as anticipated, there was a slight dip in full-time training-related employment rates (63% for 2019-20 grads, 5 percentage points down from the 2018-19 class).
- \*Consistent with previous years, most graduates surveyed stayed (95%) and were employed (93%) in Saskatchewan at the time of the survey.

\*33% of the graduates from the class of 2019-20 found employment in Saskatoon. Another 25% were employed in Regina. Average annual salary was \$46,406, down from previous two years' employment income.

#### **Graduate Satisfaction**

- \*Regardless of the Covid-19 period Sask Polytech graduates endured, overall program satisfaction remained strong. Nine in ten (94%) graduates continued to feel either very satisfied (65%) or somewhat satisfied (30%) with their program at Sask Polytech.
- \*Consistent from previous two years' results, 95% of the graduates reported they were satisfied with their decision to attend Sask Polytech.
- \*Most graduates (86%) continued to believe that their programs at least to some extent provided improved employment opportunities.

#### Further Post-Secondary Education

\*14% of the respondents indicated they were enrolled in further education at the time of the survey, of which, 67% were in full-time programs. Nearly one half (47%) of those pursuing further post-secondary education returned to Sask Polytech and most (73%) were enolled in a program related to the one they had completed at Sask Polytech.
