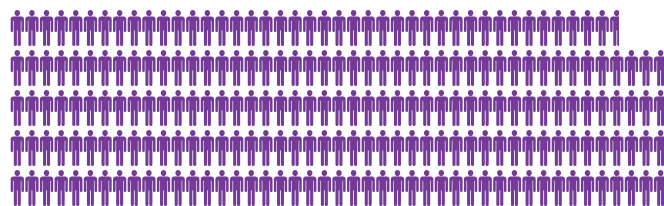


Alumni impact

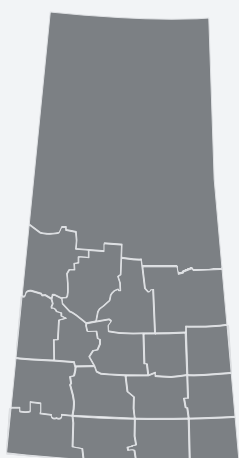
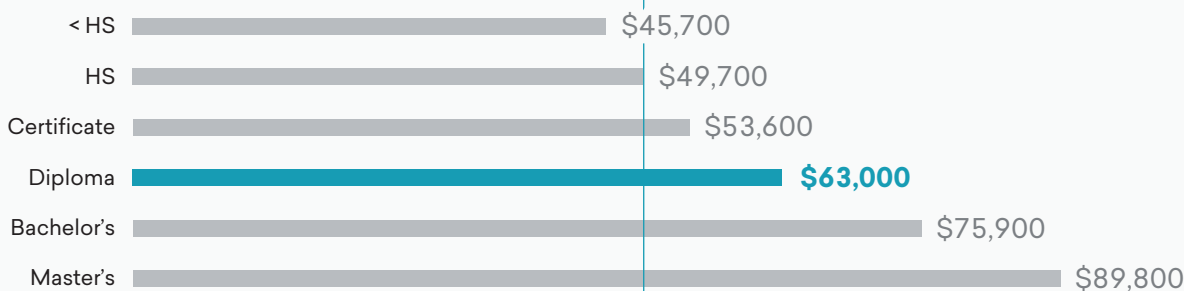

INVESTMENT ANALYSIS

The average diploma graduate from Sask Polytech will see an increase in earnings of **\$13,300** each year compared to someone with a high school diploma working in Saskatchewan.
