Girls GETT trades and tech options at SIAST

SIAST Woodland Campus GETT Camp concludes with go-kart race

July 15, 2011 – Grade 7 and 8 students from local schools have been participating in a week-long camp at SIAST Woodland Campus. Girls Exploring Trades and Technology (GETT) camps introduce girls to industrial trades and technical career choices.

"The girls had the opportunity to meet a number of great role models, women who work as electricians, welders and carpenters. Getting to see real women who do these jobs each day is an important part of letting these young women know that these careers are excellent opportunities for women!" says GETT Camp coordinator Crystal Stadnyk.

GETT campers at SIAST Woodland Campus were taught carpentry and computer design software skills as they created and assembled go-karts. The camp also reinforces the importance of course choices such as science, math and industrial arts at the high school level. The girls also had a chance to try out some electronics skills as they soldered together a circuit board to create a solar-charged night light.

The GETT camp wrapped up with a barbecue and a fun competition in which the girls raced their go-karts. The girls were recognized for their achievements at an awards ceremony.
