# SIAS Palliser hosts golf classic

*Annual scholarship event raises funds 'fore' students*

**May 25, 2005** – SIAS Palliser Campus is hosting the 15<sup>th</sup> Annual Scholarship Golf Classic on Friday, June 3, at the Hillcrest Golf Course in Moose Jaw, SK.

“Palliser’s annual Scholarship Golf Classic is an excellent opportunity for business and industry to help support post-secondary education in Moose Jaw,” says Dara Sewell-Zumstien, 2005 tournament chair. “Alumni, faculty and staff meet employers, suppliers and friends for a great day of golf for an even greater cause – student scholarships.”

Over the past 14 years, more than \$70,000 has been raised through the tournament, and more than 90 deserving SIAS Palliser Campus students have received scholarship support.

“Student scholarships help keep SIAS programs attractive to potential students seeking education in Saskatchewan and in Moose Jaw in particular,” says development and alumni coordinator Shelley Jones. “The golf classic scholarships are awarded based on a student’s academic performance, campus involvement and community volunteerism.”

The Texas best ball tournament is open to the public with a registration fee of \$100, which includes 18 holes of golf, a cart, steak barbecue and golf gift. A variety of sponsorship options are also available including hole, tee or green sponsorship, and prizes or cash sponsorship.

The tournament kicks off with registration and a chance to putt for cash from 10 to 11:30 a.m., followed by a shotgun start at noon. Further registration and sponsorship information is available by contacting Palliser’s development office at (306) 694-3958.
