Graduating students honoured for outstanding academic performance

Saskatoon, May 3, 2007 – SIAS Kelsey Campus honoured students this afternoon with scholarships and awards valued at \$130,000.

“Today’s winners have demonstrated an exceptional drive to secure their future, and ultimately the future of our families and communities, through academic achievement and technical excellence,” says SIAS president and CEO Bob McCulloch. “They’re smart, talented and hardworking, so we know the future will be in good hands.”

Today’s ceremony recognized SIAS Kelsey’s top students, including eight first-year Centennial Merit Scholarship recipients and 64 Achievement Scholarship recipients. SIAS and private donors award \$500 and \$1,000 Achievement Scholarships to graduating students in recognition of outstanding academic performance. Centennial Merit Scholarships are equal to first-year tuition. The provincial government, private donors and SIAS employees provide matching funds for Centennial Merit Scholarships, which are awarded to Saskatchewan high school students who meet high academic criteria.
