Super Saturday helps young people become familiar with careers and make links between the world of technology and traditional native culture.

SIAS Commercial Pilot grads and faculty will hold entertaining and educational hands-on activities such as radio-controlled flying, balsa glider contests, flight simulators, paper airplane building and a model parachute drop. The Super Saturday visitors will also enjoy a tour of the city with Mitchinson Flying Service, a member of the Saskatchewan Aviation Council and an employer of SIAS grads. SIAS's Commercial Pilot diploma program is offered through a partnership between SIAS and the aviation council.
