More than 40 employers attend SIAS Wascana Career Fair

February 7, 2008, Regina – SIAS Wascana Campus hosted its annual career fair in Regina today. Students from Agriculture, Applied/Visual Media, Business, Community/Human Services, Health Services, Industrial/Trades, Nursing and Technology programs had the opportunity to explore employment options with recruiting companies.

This year, 43 organizations from across Western Canada were on-site at the Conexus Arts Centre to meet with students and discuss their career goals, as well as provide insight into job opportunities available to SIAS grads.

The career fair is organized by Student Employment Services (SES) at SIAS Wascana Campus and is one of the many services that are available to SIAS students. Each campus SES office at SIAS provides students with career information, job search and recruitment services to students and employers.

“Employers are actively seeking qualified students to fill many positions available within their companies,” says Susan Szeponski, employment services coordinator, SIAS Wascana Campus. “The career fair is an excellent opportunity for our students to connect with potential employers.”
