Students honoured for outstanding academic performance

Prince Albert, November 28, 2007 – SIAS Woodland Campus honoured students this afternoon with scholarships and awards valued at \$107,385.

Today’s ceremony recognized SIAS Woodland’s top students, including 19 Centennial Merit Scholarship recipients. Through the Centennial Merit Scholarship program, Advanced Education, Employment and Labour matches donations from SIAS employees, individual donors, companies and other organizations to create scholarships equal to core tuition fees. The scholarships are awarded to Saskatchewan high school graduates who meet high academic criteria.

Two women in non-traditional trades programs were recognized for their academic achievement. Rosanne Howe received the Frank P. Remail Electrician Applied Certificate Centennial Merit Scholarship valued at \$2,500, Jocelyn Laewetz received the Frank P. Remail Welding Centennial Merit Scholarship valued at \$3,834.
