47 employers attend the Woodland Campus Job Fair

Prince Albert, February 27, 2008 – SIAS Woodland Campus hosted its annual career fair in Prince Albert today. Students from Applied/Visual Media, Business, Community/Human Services, Health Services, Hospitality/Food Services, Industrial/Trades, Natural Resources, Nursing and Technology programs had the opportunity to explore employment options with employers.

This year, 47 organizations from across Western Canada were on-site at SIAS Woodland Campus to meet with students and discuss their career goals, as well as provide insight into job opportunities available to SIAS grads.

The career fair is organized by Student Employment Services (SES) at SIAS Woodland Campus and is one of the many services that are available to SIAS students. Each campus SES office at SIAS provides students with career information, job search and recruitment services to students and employers.

“SIAS grads are in high demand,” says Anne Holz, employment services coordinator, SIAS Woodland Campus. “This is the most business and industry participation we have ever seen at our job fair. It is obvious there is a need for qualified candidates when

employers are recruiting before students complete their programs.” The career fair provides an opportunity for students to make face-to-face connections with potential employers.
