

Saskatchewan Polytechnic Student Outstanding Citizenship Award

A Student Outstanding Citizenship Award will be presented each year, to one Sask Polytech student at each campus. This award will recognize a student who has inspired and encouraged others to make positive changes. The outstanding work will demonstrate benefits to the campus community and others.

The entry will recognize an individual that demonstrates achievement in the following areas:

- Leadership
- Initiative and dedication to their studies
- Evidence of community involvement
- Role model within the student community
- Active contribution to the program and/or campus (e.g. volunteering, committee work, etc.)
- Demonstration of strong personal character, integrity and professionalism

Value:

The awards will consist of a \$500 cash prize to an individual recipient. Each individual will also receive a framed certificate.

Nominations:

Nominations will be accepted until **March 18, 2022**. Students must be nominated by a Sask Polytech faculty and two additional faculty confirmations are required. The nomination, of approximately 400-600 words, should summarize how the students work meets the criteria outlined above.

Complete submissions, with all faculty confirmations, **must be received by 4:00 p.m.** on March 4, 2022, via email to convocation@saskpolytech.ca.
