

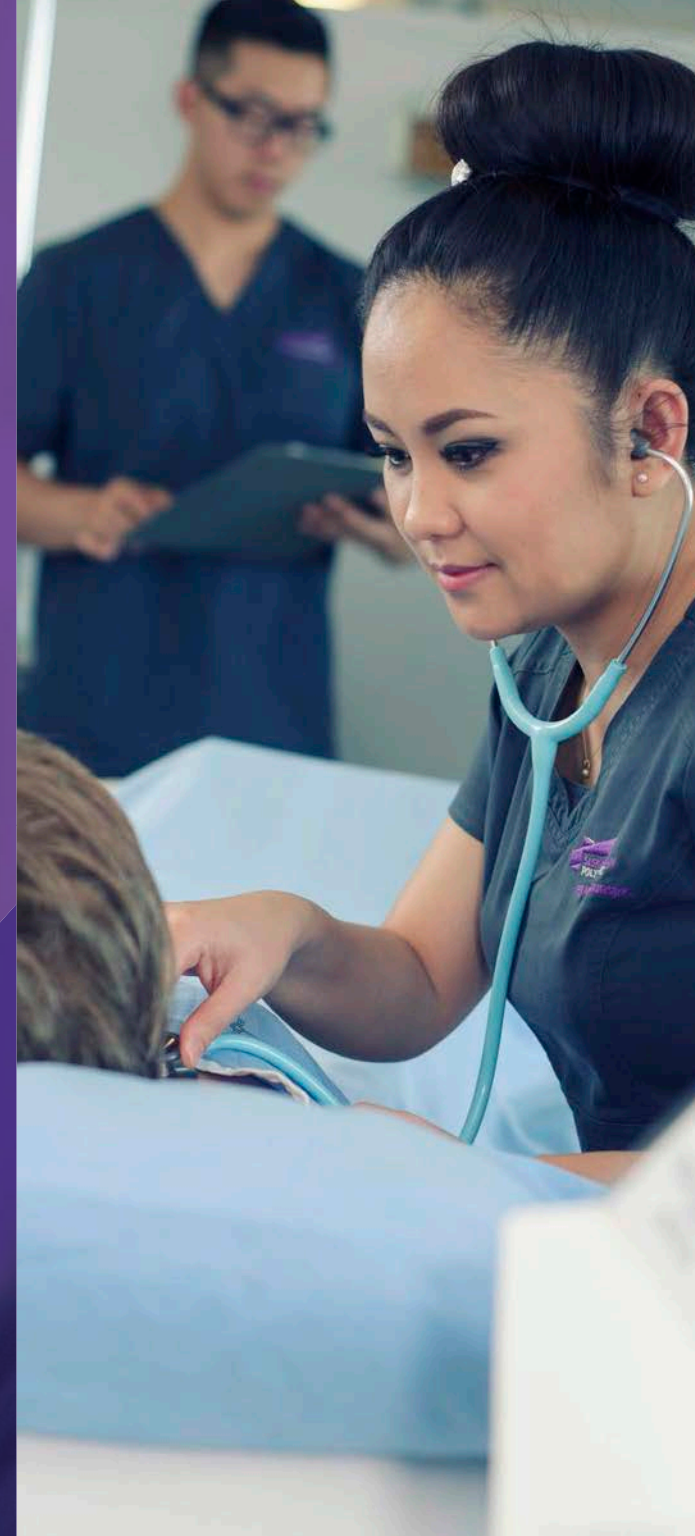

EARN A DEGREE.

The Bachelor of Psychiatric Nursing Degree Completion program gives grads of Sask Polytech's Psychiatric Nursing diploma program the opportunity to earn a psychiatric nursing degree in two years. The Saskatchewan Collaborative Bachelor of Science in Nursing program is offered jointly by Saskatchewan Polytechnic and the University of Regina and can be completed in three or four years. Saskatchewan Polytechnic and the University of Regina also offer the Collaborative Nurse Practitioner Program which leads to the Master of Nursing (Nurse Practitioner) degree.

SERVICES

Aboriginal Nursing Student Achievement Program

Two Sask Polytech Aboriginal nursing student advisors are available to counsel and support the recruitment, enrolment, retention and success of nursing students of Aboriginal ancestry.

Internationally Educated Nurses Assessment Centre

The Internationally Educated Nurses (IEN) Assessment Centre assesses the professional knowledge, judgment and skills of IENs and supports them in completing their registration requirements in Saskatchewan.

Regina Campus Nurse Practitioner Services

Faculty, staff and students can access primary health care services for illness prevention, health education and treatment of common acute and chronic conditions.
