SASKATCHEWAN POLYTECHNIC DUAL CREDIT COURSES

If you are a Saskatchewan high school student thinking of becoming a Saskatchewan Polytechnic student in the future, consider dual credit. Dual credit allows you to earn high school credit and Saskatchewan Polytechnic credit at the same time.

Dual credit courses are offered through distance education* options with the majority of the content delivered as self-study. Communication between the Saskatchewan Polytechnic instructor and the high school student is carried out via email and/or telephone. Exams are written at the student's high school under the supervision of the principal.

In most cases, the high school course mark is awarded based on the student's achievement in the Saskatchewan Polytechnic course. Saskatchewan Polytechnic dual credit courses are available to students anywhere in the province, subject to the participation of the school division.
