



INDIGENOUS STUDENT EMERGENCY BURSARY APPLICATION

Indigenous Student Emergency Bursary is based on student financial **urgent need** for essentials – food, shelter, medicine, and other unanticipated costs related to being in school. It may be available only if all other possibilities for emergency funds have been exhausted, and if it is clear that this bursary will contribute to student success. If it is clear that awarding this bursary will not assist the student in continuing their studies, the request will be denied.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Be enrolled full full-time in a Sask Polytech post-secondary program of study of 20 weeks or greater at any Sask Polytech campus.
- Be of self-declared Aboriginal ancestry (includes First Nation, Non-Status, Métis, and Inuit) and provide documentation of ancestry, if not previously verified with Registration Services.
- Basic Education students and Apprentices are not eligible for this bursary due to their funding source

Selection Criteria:

- Urgent and temporary financial need supported by documentation.
- Students must include an explanation on how the funds will be spent.
- Documentation of financial information form completed.
- Award is maximum \$500 per academic year.

Students must meet with a Student Advisor or Counsellor for Indigenous Students to review their application
