

# Saskatchewan Polytechnic International Mobility Award Application

The Saskatchewan Polytechnic International Mobility Award provides financial assistance to students participating in an international study and/or work experience as part of their studies. The Award is intended to encourage and facilitate international experiences for Saskatchewan Polytechnic students to gain international exposure, enrich their learning, broaden their cultural understanding, and see the global reach of their field of study. The award is designed to defray the travel-related costs of an international experience.

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

To be eligible to receive a Saskatchewan Polytechnic International Mobility Award, a student must;

- 1. have been selected by their academic program to participate in an international experience.
- 2. be enrolled in a full-time Saskatchewan Polytechnic or collaborative partner's certificate, diploma, degree or post-graduate certificate program. (Students with special circumstances which prevent full-time status should provide separate documentation for consideration).
- 3. have completed at least one semester of their program.
- 4. have a minimum grade point average of 70% in the previous term of study and be in good academic standing at the time of application.
- 5. submit on or with their application:
  - A statement of interest of 300-500 words describing the purpose of travel and how it will benefit both the student's academic program and professional development.
  - o International Mobility Participant Confirmation signed by the program head confirming the student's acceptance to a Saskatchewan Polytechnic authorized international experience.

Students can receive only one Saskatchewan Polytechnic International Mobility Award per academic year of their program.

#### **Selection Criteria:**

Selection will be based on:

• Statement of Interest of 300-500 words describing the purpose of travel and how it will benefit both the student's academic program and professional development.

DEADLINES FOR APPLICATION ARE JAN. 30, MARCH 15, JULY 15, and OCT. 15.

- Transcript of marks from the most recent completed semester.
