First Qualified First Admitted (FQFA) checklist

The FQFA process is used for most programs. The sooner an application is received, the earlier that applicant may qualify for admission.

Applications are accepted year-round and considered for the next available start date.

STEP 2: Submit required documents

 Upload copies of required documents in the Sask Polytech Applicant Hub. Some circumstances/programs may require extras (e.g., first aid, CPR, typing tests).

Transcripts:

- Transcripts must be sent directly from the issuing institution or via MyCreds to Sask Polytech.
- Saskatchewan high school students: Order via saskatchewan.ca/transcripts.
- Out-of-province students: Contact your provincial/institutional office to send transcripts directly.
- Mail should only be used if the original institution cannot send directly via MyCreds.
- Deadline: All final transcripts must be received 30 days before the program start date.

I'm upgrading high school subjects	 ✓ Upload interim transcript from your school. ✓ Request your final transcripts be sent to Sask Polytech as instructed above.
I am out of high school	✓ Request official transcripts to be sent directly to Sask Polytech as instructed above.
I'm a domestic applicant with foreign credentials	✓ Upload a colour copy of your PR card, proof of English proficiency and translated transcript. (Translation help: atisask.ca)
