

Merlis Belsher


Merlis Belsher grew up on the family farm and attended elementary school at McCord, a small village in southwestern Saskatchewan named after his pioneer grandfather.

Following the accidental death of his parents, Merlis entered Luther College in Regina to complete grades 11 and 12. He attended the University of Saskatchewan earning a Bachelor of Commerce degree. He continued his education to become a Chartered Accountant. Merlis then returned to the U of S to earn a Bachelor of Law degree following which he was admitted to the Law Society of Saskatchewan.

One year following admission to the Bar as a lawyer, with assistance from a friendly bank and the company vendors, Merlis was able to acquire ownership of a Saskatoon based concrete products manufacturing company. His entire career was in Saskatchewan. Together with diligent employees he grew this manufacturing operation to become one of the most diversified precast concrete plants in Western Canada. The business was sold in 2008. Attached to his roots, he continues to have farming interests at McCord.

Merlis has always been involved in his community in Saskatoon. This included years serving in non-profit, church, business, political organizations and years of involvement in sports as a coach and supporter.

His philanthropic endeavours include the University of Saskatchewan, Luther College of Regina, Royal University Hospital Foundation, St. Paul's Hospital Foundation, Saskatoon City Hospital Foundation, and initiatives to improve health care, education and ongoing support of charities. He is most proud of two areas of support with special needs: an Access to Justice Fund that provides experiential learning opportunities for law students to serve the public, and the sponsorships of the Adult and Adolescence wing in the Irene and Leslie Dube Mental Health Centre in Saskatoon.



During his career he has received numerous awards including an Honorary Doctor of Law and Alumni Achievement Award from the University of Saskatchewan, the Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee Medal, Senior Life Membership from the Law Society of Saskatchewan, designation as Fellow from the Institute of Chartered Professional Accountants of Saskatchewan, the SABEX Hall of Fame Award by the Greater Saskatoon Chamber of Commerce, and the Junior Achievement Business Hall of Fame Award.

Merlis has one daughter, four sons and three grandchildren.

Applied Research Award for Excellence

Working with industry and the community in applied research and innovation,
Saskatchewan Polytechnic owes its successes to the individual and collective efforts of its faculty and researchers. By partnering in innovation and testing, Sask Polytech enables companies to capture new opportunities, solve everyday problems and contribute to economic growth and job creation in Saskatchewan. This award program recognizes excellence in applied research and innovation.

Faculty Award for Excellence: Teaching

As a recognized leader in the development and delivery of skills and technical training, Saskatchewan Polytechnic owes its success to the individual and collective efforts of its faculty and staff. Our faculty award program recognizes excellence in service and innovation as a significant component to making our institution a key contributor to Saskatchewan's economic and social development. The Faculty Awards for Excellence: Teaching are intended to recognize, acknowledge, and reward Sask Polytech faculty for outstanding teaching. Up to five awards for recognition of excellence in teaching are presented each year.

Governor General's Academic Medals

The Governor General's Academic Medal was first awarded in 1873 by the Earl of Dufferin, and has since become one of the most prestigious awards that a student in a Canadian educational institution can receive. The Governor General of Canada continues this tradition of encouraging scholarship across the nation and recognizing outstanding students. The medals are awarded only for academic excellence as follows:

- · Bronze at the secondary school level
- Collegiate Bronze at the post-secondary diploma level

Honorary Diploma

Since the first Honorary Diploma was awarded in 2004, Sask Polytech has been recognizing extraordinary individuals who are making a difference in communities throughout Saskatchewan and beyond. Honorary Diplomas are presented to individuals who have made a significant contribution to education, business and industry, or government, and who are supportive of Sask Polytech's vision, values, and overall role in the local and provincial communities.



Student Outstanding Citizenship Award

A Student Outstanding Citizenship Award may be presented each year to one Saskatchewan Polytechnic student at each campus. This award recognizes a student who has inspired and encouraged others to make positive changes. Nominated by Sask Polytech faculty, the student's outstanding work demonstrates benefits to the campus community and others.

Student Innovation Award

A Student Innovation Award is presented each year to a Saskatchewan Polytechnic student or team. This award recognizes a student, or team of students, who has/have achieved a high standard of excellence on an innovative project, or demonstrated innovative methods within their program of study.
